Stott's Colleges Refund Policy

In accepting Stott's Colleges' offer through signing the current and valid Stott's Colleges' Student Acceptance Form (not this application fom), the student enters into a legally binding agreement with Stott's Colleges, including agreement to be bound by the Stott's Colleges' Refund Policy. The policy is as follows:

1. A refund of 70% of tuition fee will be given if an enrolment is cancelled more than 28 days prior to commencement of the course.

2. No refund of tuition fee will be given if an enrolment is cancelled within 28 days of course commencement, or the student does not commence on the agreed date, or withdraws from the

- course once it has commenced. Students enrolling to commence courses within 28 days of application will not receive a refund if enrolment is cancelled more than seven (7) days after receipt of the application or within seven (7) days of course commencement.

- No refund will be given to any student who has deferred their enrolment. Early termination of homestay is subject to a 20% cancellation fee on monies paid.
- Where proof of visa rejection is provided, refund will be calculated in accordance with ESOS Regulations 3.19(2) & (3). In accordance with the regulations, refund will be provided less:
 - any paid representative's fee;
 - h \$250 administration fees:
 - 5% of the total tuition fee received for the course before the default day;
 - expenses for travel, accommodation and other domestic services that cannot be offset by providing the services to someone else;
 - the cost of books and other materials needed for the course; and
- the cost of books and other inaterials needed for the course, and if the student has commenced study, refund will be provided less the proportion of the course money that Stott's Colleges has received in respect of the student before the default day that is equal to the proportion of the course that was provided to the student before the default day. Stott's Colleges may grant no refund if a student's enrolment is cancelled or a student's visa or application for visa is cancelled or refused due to actions of the student
- Stott's Colleges reserves the right to cancel or not offer a program. If any program is cancelled and/or not offered, in accordance with sections 27 and 29 of the Education Services for Overseas Students Act 2000, and the ESOS regulations 2001 (as amended), one of the following options will be offered: Any unused portion of tuition fees paid by the student will be refunded, within two (2) weeks from the date of default; or
 An alternative course or part course can be arranged at the providers' expense. If accepted by the student the payment of course fees will be paid to the alternative

provider within two (2) weeks from the date of notice of default.

8. Tuition fees are not transferable to another person.

This policy and the availability of Stott's Complaints and Appeals Policies do not remove from the student the right to take further action under Australian Consumer Protection laws or to pursue other legal remedies
